The Champaign County Board of Developmental Disabilities funds all providers of service for people with developmental disabilities. We fund the following private providers of day support services:

(Funding for providers is approximately 40% local dollars and 60% federal dollars.)

Local dollars also support the staff who monitor the quality of services delivered by all providers, develop the plan of support for each person, and ensure the health and welfare of all people with developmental disabilities.



Additionally, the county board provides Early Intervention services for children from birth to age three. The services of a Developmental Specialist, Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, and PLAY Project Coordinator are available for each child based on need.
